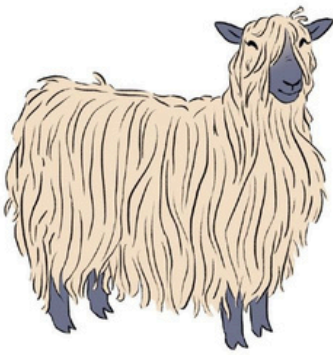

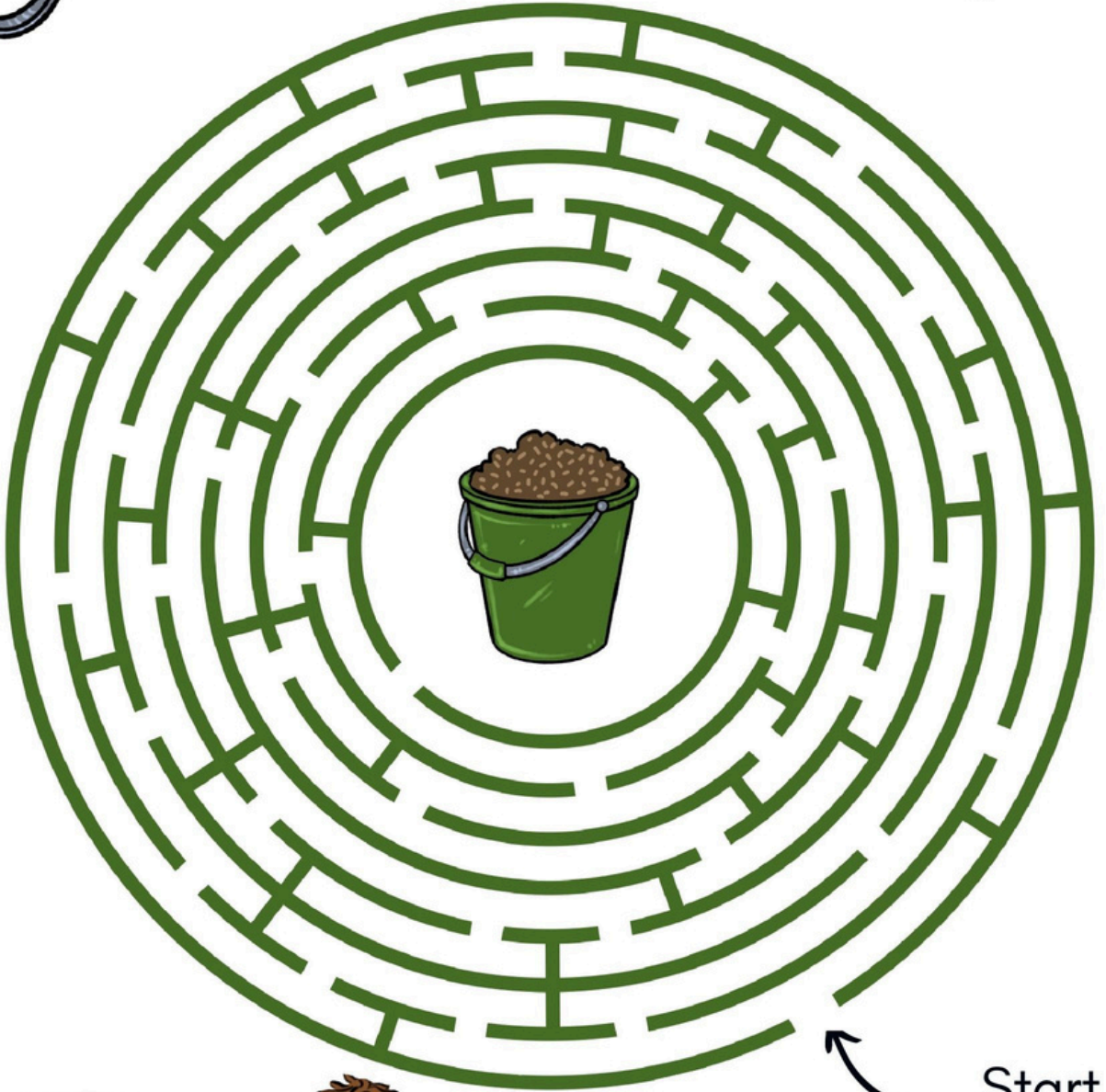

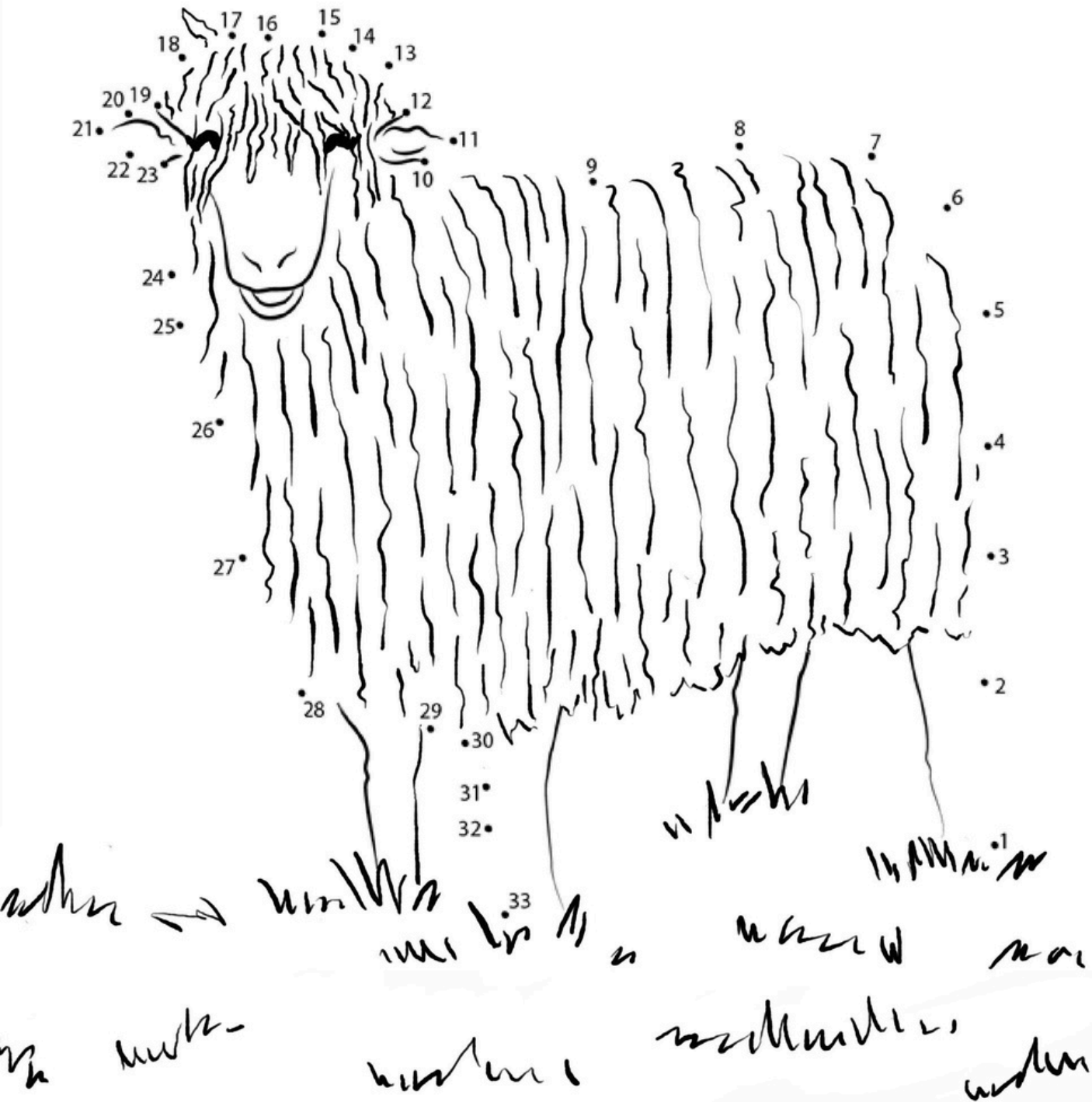

Answers
1. Wensleydales come from Wensleydale, in the North Yorkshire Dales

6. Black Wensleydales have orange tags and white Wensleydales have blue tags
