Important Notes

All Sheep entered in the sale must be registered and have ear tags in accordance with DEFRA guidelines as well as an official WLSBA tag. Lambs should be registered with plenty of time to allow the ordering and delivery of tags.

Full Inspection guidelines can be found in the Articles of Association or in the WLSBA flock book. All sheep will be inspected prior to show/sale by pre-nominated Breed Inspectors.

- a. "The function of Breed Inspectors is to confirm that entries are typical of the breed standard as given in the flock book, that they meet size and weight criteria and that they have an official WLSBA tag in the ear which is consistent with the catalogue entry. Any entry which, in the opinion of the Inspector, does not meet these requirements, is to be rejected by the Inspector and the vendor and auctioneer advised that the entry should not be offered for sale."

The minimum weight criteria for the WLSBA Show/Sales as published in the Flock Book are:

Rams - 90kgs (198lbs)

Ram Lambs - 45kgs (99lbs)

Ewes - 65kgs (143lbs)

Ewe Lambs - 40kgs (88lbs)

All sheep that are deemed to have faults in the mouth by the inspectors will have a red sticker placed upon their lot number. The sheep will still be allowed to be sold through the ring but at buyers own risk. The idea is NOT to have to place red stickers on sheep but that vendors will strictly check their own sheep prior to entering the sale and only sell top quality sheep at society shows & sales. This may be extended to other conformational faults in future years if it is felt to be beneficial. All sheep will be sold in the ring. MV Sheep will be sold first in class order, followed by Non-MV in class order. Vendor order will be selected at random by ballot by class. Class order is as follows:

1. Aged Ewe > 2. Shearling Ewe > 3. Ewe Lamb > 4. Aged Ram > 5. Shearling Ram > 6. Ram Lamb
